AR serves as the utility token for Arweave. All network fees, including those for data storage, retrieval, and interactions with decentralized applications (DApps), are paid using \$AR. Users looking to store data on the Arweave blockchain must use \$AR to cover the costs of distributed storage. Additionally, computers providing storage services on the network receive their incentives exclusively in \$AR tokens.

Governance: “Arweave’s governance model allocates decision-making power to token holders, giving them the ability to shape the future of the network. By holding AR tokens, individuals have the right to propose and vote on protocol upgrades, network parameters, and even funding initiatives. This democratic process ensures that all stakeholders have a say in the direction of Arweave’s development.”
